Dear Bro ^{Wm}

We'll scratch off a few lines
this afternoon. This is the last
letter on this side the pond. mail
closes at 6 p.m. this date. Orders
are to leave Strunzberg the 8th like
30 Kil to Strunzberg Germany and enter
the 10th. will have 3 days travel
through Germany + France and
Emperors at Bruch France, soon after
arriving. we are doing practically
nothing now, in the line of military
work. Willie I rec your letter
yesterday and was very glad to
hear from you before leaving. when
I get on the other side I will let
you know. If there is anything

you want when I get back, don't
be afraid to write - let me know
I will certainly give the folks your
best regards and stand at ease.
I hope you will follow soon
after. Take good care of yourself.
